

Sat 14th May 27 The Parsi High-Priest
At Meherabad.

The Parsi High-Priest Dashtorhai.....
of Navsari arrived at Meherabad this morning as already expected. He was taken straight before Baba in the New-Ashram premises where Shri gave him tea and then allowed him a short private interview, when it is believed the Dashtorji related his spiritual aspirations for himself and for his community and the various difficulties with which he had to put up with from the public for his such bent of mind, before Baba in details. After that, when some of the mandali were also present, Baba conveyed very absorbing explanations to the Dashtorji on various divine subjects including the Four States of God, the Four Kinds of ~~Yagnas~~ Yagnins (faiths) - God, Saushers, Maya, & Realization. The visitor seemed to be deeply impressed with what he heard and also said that he would like to speak publicly before the Parsi community according to the points given by Baba on certain ^{the} subjects. At this Shri conveyed to him that if he would follow His - Baba's - instructions to the letter and the spirit, he would not only be made to understand the true aspects of Truth merely through intellect but - also to experience and actually see certain things, so that he can then speak with authority. The Dashtorji seemed willing to obey Babas orders and instructions, and in the course of some further remarks Shri conveyed to him not to worry about anything now save following His advise properly & and He - Baba - will look to all the rest of the difficulties and

questioned Himself. The Dashtorji was also referred to as having been an Aryan in the previous life by Baba who also added to the remark that the Aryans had three different branches, the Hindus, the Parsis and the.....?

After passing sometime in this way with Baba, the guest was conducted to Masajis' quarters in the "Post-Office" where he remained arrangements for his food and stay were made.

In the evening the Baba again went to the Ashram for sometime and in His absence the Dashtorji came out and joined the mandali, and freely mixed and talked with all. He also took part in the usual Arti with great devotion when it took place after Shri's return from the Ashram. Instead of the stories about an hour was passed in general discussions till nine thirty o'clock when all were ordered to go to sleep. The Dashtorji was also asked to take a good sleep and see Shri the following morning after tea, for further divine-explanations.

However after the Dashtorji had retired, Baba called for 'Chauji' and discussed with him about the guest for sometime when Shri conveyed amongst other things His appreciation of the Dashtorji's devotion to spirituality. It was nearly eleven thirty when Baba, and Gurkholji (who was also present during this discussion) retired for the night.

Pilamai, Khorshed-Banos and boys arrived from Karachi this morning. The latter are to be put in the Ashram. As promised to him last night, Baba conveyed some more explanations to the Dastoorji again this morning. Rustonji and 'Changi' were also present on the occasion, and the latter has taken notes in details elsewhere of the fine expositions, together with the figures and diagrams that were also drawn at the time under Shri's guidance.

Later on the Dastoorji was further entertained with ^{narrations of} Baba's early life activities by Mother Shireenbanoo herself. (Vide 'Changi's notes)

In the afternoon the Dastoorji left Hyderabad to catch the evening train for Bombay with 'Changi' who accompanied him to see him off at the station.

Before his departure Baba examined for Himself the wounds that the Dastoorji had on his leg, ordered some sacred ash to be given to him and once again conveyed to him to not to worry any more.

When the train passed through Hyderabad the Dastoorji was seen making a final respectful salute to Shri and also acknowledged the cheerful send-off waved at him by the mandali. When 'Changi' returned from the station, the letters he had with the Dastoorji showed that besides being a keen enthusiast on spirituality himself the Dastoorji was equally very anxious to lead the community at large on this line too, through public lectures and writings specially on the points explained to him by Baba.
