A Hindu lepar and sanyasin came for Shri's Darshan. He was fed and then asked by Baba to sit for sometime in the village temple and proceed to Walli in the evening. Before complying with this order, the sanyasin requested of Shri for a covering as he had nothing to protect himself from cold. Baba at once took off His own rug and presented it to ~~the~~ him as is His wont to do in such cases. In fact rugs and coverings are never safe about Baba's Person.
