In the evening a prolonged ~~meeting~~ meeting of all the mandali was called together by Baba.

For nearly three hours different subjects were thought upon and discussed. The chief items being whether a receipt was to be given to the Store-Keeper Gustedji, every time that anyone from the mandali received the various necessities and the other was Baba's explanation in connection with the description of the spiritual planes. ~~in~~ About the latter, Baba said he was going to have explanatory plans and diagrams prepared with one or the other of a circle member which will express ~~the~~ some idea of the ~~than~~ different planes to the public ^{at all}, as has never been done by any Master so far, although all of them did ~~try to~~ give hints or explained these things in a difficult terms. While the first question in connection with the Stores issues was unani-

ously left to the discretion of the Store-Keeper himself.

At 9.30. all retired for the night when Baba ~~re~~ repaired to his new seat under the Mim tree. But nowadays Shri ~~somes~~ is often marked moving about even in the night & generally seen seated in the school premises busy writing the Future Book. He did not take any solid food but had a little of tea & chal water today.

Thurs 29.10.25

The moment Baba came out of his new retirement from under the Table seat by 7.30. that he was faced with quite a crowd of visitors, to all of whom he patiently allowed ~~for~~ respects paying and smilingly accepted the garlands & ~~the~~ flowers offered to him. At the same time he did not forget

to make his usual daily inquiries of every individual from the mandali through signs & even writing ~~written~~ about one's sleep, food, health etc etc. Rambhaos Mali ^{who} ~~had~~ managed to get Baba's permission after repeated request that he made in this connection on suitable occasions to open a flower shop on Thursdays Sundays and holidays ~~on~~ in consideration of the large number of visitors that came for Shri's Darshans from all parts of the country, did open one today along the Dind-Deogar road. Inspite of enormous crowds Baba patiently heard all and ~~for~~ in many cases gave suitable replies and advises ~~by~~ through slate-writing. A boy through some mischievous motives brought some astrological questions which were all replied to correctly by Baba who asked the boy through signs ^{wether} he came to him thinking him to be an Astrologer, the boy ~~said~~ replying in the negative Shri advised him at length very patiently but firmly through writing the dangers of trying to tamper with Spiritual Personalities.

At 12 after dinner again a meeting of the colony residents was called together. Baba discussed upon some spiritual ~~matters~~ subjects as well as some domestic matters were considered and decided upon.

In the afternoon when all had been to Gur Shanes place for the usual Thursday tea party then also Baba dwelt at length on divine topics and explained through writing how the ~~Saints~~ Samskars are cut away and destroyed by a Sadguru.

After this all the boys were shaved and given batas by Baba, ~~the~~ Director, Superintendent and the teaching staff with their own hands.

There was a busy programme in the night

too. More explanations were given preceding the usual evening Bhajan which ~~was~~ was followed by a few exciting games of Aka-Pata lasting till 10.30 P.M.

Sat 31st Oct '25

On account of Tri-puri Purnima the enthusiastic Arjoonrao who has a great inclination towards the observance of ceremonies arranged another ceremonial bath for Baba. Accordingly at 3 in the afternoon the 'Mangal Saman' was begun. Baba patiently & smilingly put away with the great inconvenience of being bathed by hundreds of people in one sitting.

However, after the bath, Aka, and Puja, Baba asked those responsible for such affairs not to repeat the bathing affair again & again so he had got cough & cold since the last Bath.

Again a few games of Aka-Pata were indulged in by all including Baba after the evening Bhajans late till 10.30 P.M.

Baba's Ill. Health.

For the last five days Baba is not keeping a good health. The cough and cold seem to trouble him more and more day by day in the absence of regular treatment. But this did not stop him from doing his daily services as usual. On the contrary Sri seems to be more diligent with his pen and he keeps on writing even in the night time.

The Editor of and some rich friends were amongst the daily visitors. They seemed to be so very much pleased with all the institutions and their excellent management that they offered some financial help to Baba for these institutions. But Sri politely refused the offer and wrote back on slate "I am a Daker and so what I have to do with money God is ~~not~~ too enough for us."

The inpatients of the Hospital having considerably increased the girl's school premises were added to the Hospital department to make room for more beds, and the Girls school was removed in the Krugan village Naler Chordi. Similarly some more residential readjustments were also made today. Waman tailor and his family were removed in the grinding room, while the grinding ~~room~~ was ~~of the~~ department was fixed in a corner of the Dharmashala with bamboo matting partitions round it.
