

Sun. 8. 11. 25.

special family quarters was made when one and all the boys and mandali were abundantly served with Bhejyas Ladoos Chivda and tea.

In the evening a short sports programme was held and <sup>the names of</sup> those coming first in different races were noted down for Prizes which were declared to be distributed tomorrow. To crown it all Baba asked <sup>the party</sup> ~~to~~ to enter into a competitive Fancy-dress parties <sup>& groups</sup> and offered prizes for the most original and funniest dresses and acting <sup>too</sup>. Consequently a very jolly time was witnessed by all and a great merriment ruled uppermost amongst the mandali till 11 in the night when all retired for ~~the~~ night rest & sleep.

Tues. 10. 11. 25.

### 'Dhooni Lighting'

After, all the various activities and works were gone through as usual by Shri & the mandali, Baba conducted them near his new seat in the night and there the 'Dhooni' (a fire-place) was duly ~~lighted~~ lighted at about 11 o'clock after which all were allowed to retire for the night. There was a great scarcity of rain, and without a final good shower a local famine was decided for. Without any previous signs just after an hour or so of the 'Dhooni' lighting it began to rain very heavily! xxx Please read addition attached here (About Khudamward)

Wed. 11. 11. 25.

For nearly 15 hours the raining continued at a stretch, after commencing last night following the Dhooni lighting, and deluged the dying crops ~~with~~ in abundance. A serious famine was just avoided in the nick of time with the unexpected blessing! The mandali

were asked to compose poetry on the 'Dhooi'. In the afternoon the school was closed and the poetic flights of all were heard and judged upon. Rustonji, Padri, Pandoba and Kisan were declared to be 1st to 4th respectively in merits of good poetry compositions.

In view of the cold bleak winds and the surrounding moisture on account of the heavy rains all the Incherabad residents were given quinine pills by Baba to avoid any undue change in <sup>their</sup> health.

After some gramophone playing the party went to sleep at 10. P.M.

Thur. 12.11.25.

Baba came out of that cupboard of a seat before 6.30. in the morning and as usual enquired of all those who came for his Darshans <sup>about</sup> ~~the~~ their health and sleep.

The next move on Shri's part was to personally see that all necessary things were supplied and the corpse of a weak old and sick Incher who died this morning in the Dherinashala, was duly taken ~~to~~ away ~~to~~ for final disposal.

In the afternoon the usual Thursday tea party was held at Mr Shahane's residence when every one to the mandali was allotted a fixed duty and occupation by Baba and instructions were in this connection imparted to all respectively through slate writing and signs.

The crowd ~~was~~ of visitors was again marked to be very great today.

Sat 14.11.25.

In addition to all the usual business and activities the school boys were all shaved, and given baths by Baba

and some of the mandali with their own hands

15.11.25. Sunday

The day was again observed as a holiday, and attempts to make it as lively as possible were begun from the early morning. A few but interesting games of *Aha-Pala* were played before sitting in to hear Mr. - Angel's *Puran* when Baba received a severe push accidentally through Arjunrao's running into Him. From 9 to 11 all were deeply engaged in listening the beautiful *Puranic* lectures which were also attentively heard by the great crowd of 'sunday' visitors to Baba. <sup>after a cup of khiricropet/ply-</sup> At 4 P.M. a tea party was held at Mr. Shahu's place when Shri explained through slate writings the *Sanskars* of bad and impure actions.

After the *Shojans* again all were asked to bring in *riti*. A committee consisting of gal *Ajita* and Shahu ~~was~~ was appointed to be the judges in awarding marks to the most successful of the *riti* parties to be entitled ~~them~~ to receive the prizes tomorrow. Consequently a very happy and humorous time was passed by all before one more day came to an end of the *Inchhabad* life came to an end.

Mon. 16.11.25.

The 'Shooni' was cooled down for some repairs and after their completion the same was relighted when again at 9 P.M. it began to rain very heavily! flooding the surrounding country to some extent. Prizes were duly distributed to those who stood highest in merit of their acting or dressing achievements last night. The *Inchhabad* flooding being all well Baba ~~took~~ called the mandali to sleep near him in the school premises tonight.
