This afternoon Mr Ansal pleader and Bhaoosab Bhaijansari and many more of Shri's devotees at Tagar began to pour in, <sup>thereabout</sup> one after the other in a very excited condition. Their fast haste arrival at that odd hour was due to a strong rumour having somehow got spread in Ahmednagar that Shri Baba had left the body! Whether the rumour

originated through some misunderstanding or was  
purposely instigated by some mischievous agencies  
~~was never found~~ could not be decided for certain.

Be it, as it may there was an ~~an~~ unusual  
crowd of people from Ahmednagar to witness for  
themselves the rumoured incident. At this Baba  
declared with signs that for the next 26 years He would  
not leave his body even if the heavens and earth  
came together for that purpose, after that it would be  
a question of fancy on his part, although He would  
not retain his bodily connection after 90 years at  
the most.

The usual Bhajans and Purans were  
held as on every Sunday. In view of the ever increasing  
visitors and the consequent large number of motors  
and carriages that obstruct the road here and there,  
arrangements were made today by marking out

Thur. 28. 1. 26. Baba Jan's Birthday.

Hazrat Baba Jan's birthday was observed today.  
The school and dispensary were closed for the day. In  
addition to that, it being Thursday the crowd of visitors  
was unusual and the colony was ringing with one  
or the other of the ceremonies, bhajans etc throughout  
the day. Specially the actual "Birth" ceremony in the

evening was witnessed to be a very enthusiastic and  
 devotional function with the ringing hymn, the  
 sweet Aarti repetitions and the devotional swinging  
 of a small 'cradle'. At the conclusion of which Baba  
 distributed sweets to all. At the tea party at Gur-  
 Ishan's place this afternoon Baba dwelt at length  
 on the delicate question of the 'Vital fluid'. The  
 party were clearly explained all the aspects of this  
 very necessary (but generally avoided under a false  
 sense of modesty) ~~topic~~ subject which is generally  
 avoided under a false sense of modesty. All lusty  
 discharges were termed to be very bad whether <sup>resulting</sup> through  
 natural or unnatural means excepting the passing  
 of the matter while dreaming. This was said to  
 be due to 1. Vulgar thoughts entertained in the day  
 time 2. Indigestion 3. Past sanskars. So far as  
 Hence bad thoughts should not be entertained  
 and the mind be kept engaged in Service with  
 love and devotion. ~~The even the loving relation~~  
~~between man & wife inspite of the~~ Similarly  
 proper care of health should be observed. Excepting  
 the relations between man & wife which are generally  
 based upon the mutual love, such indulgences  
 were again & again during the explanations impressed  
 upon all to be very dangerous as the Sanskars were  
 thereby increased enormously. ~~Spending~~ Spending  
 up the body was said to be essential. But not  
 spending it away with discharges! On the contrary  
 the body was to be spent away in the ~~long~~ Service  
 of Love and the Love of God. The rains do a  
 lot of good, without which people would not get  
 food and drink but it should rain <sup>in</sup> at the right way.

Otherwise, Baba added referring to the shower that had come that day " such untimely showers instead of bringing about prosperity, cause damage to crops & human life ~~has~~ through a bad climate " It was for nearly two hours that Baba kept on explaining the subject with signs and writing, ~~to the full~~ completely convincing the party with the home-truths of his assertions.
