Fri. 11. 6. 26.

Baba came down today at 9.30.

Of late, since four or five days Baba has been sitting in the small tonga. He ~~was~~ came by that tonga today from Kaka's place to the Guckan. Baba also played ~~for some~~ cricket for sometime this evening. The party were to go to Ram - Gurtis' circus this evening but the programme was cancelled at the eleventh hour as Adi could not spare the motor conveyance as per prearrangement.

When Baba was informed about it, He said so much the better, the whole of the existence is a circus show if one cares to see it that way, instead of troubling oneself in going to a circus itself. However the mandali ~~were~~ did not after all miss a good amusement.
