The lectures afforded a great amusement to all and were listened to attentively. At the conclusion Baba gave out marks of appreciation on the merits of every lecture on a competitive basis and then all retired for the night.

Wed 21.10.25.

A Shave After Nine Months!

For the last 9 months Baba did not shave his beard but this afternoon he got himself shaved by Gangaram alias Kana-Mogul the Manzil-Barber who had come for his Darshan after a long time. The rest of ^{the} daily programme was gone through as usual.

sleeping soundly, Gustādji ~~sent~~ ^{let out} a ^{hoos} sharp and shrill ~~shout~~ sharply blew the danger whistle renting the silence of the quite night - echoing and reechoing with the shrill sounds of the ~~whistle~~ same. Immediately there was a great commotion in the Mahan, and in less time than it takes to write one after the other, the Mahan members began to file out with formidable sticks kept ^{handy} near each ^{of them} member under Shree's order. By the time all had assembled near the Shree, that Gustādji informed them that there was nothing serious. Apparently a rat had jumped over an occupant of the Ladies quarters which made her cry out ~~at~~ and ~~the~~ and at the sound of which Gustādji let go his powerful whistle. In the absence of real danger and the consequent disappearance of the prospect of an exciting time the mandali became alive to the chill of the night and the pull of the sleep. And Baba's devotees have much reason to be attracted towards him on account of ^{the} innumerable blessings that one or the other receives according to the respective faiths and devotions. For instance Bapurao Talati of Arunnam had a complicated ~~legal~~ litigation going on in the courts which was decided today in his favour just as Baba had told him as well as his three small children were just saved from sure death while sleeping in the house when a big piece of timber crashed on them through accident - but missed the children only by inches. Mr Rusdon of Bombay had a very painful and swollen hand when he came to Shri who asked him to pass the same over His - Baba's - forehead and it ~~is~~ was immediately relieved to a great extent. Similarly ^{when} Waman tailor of the colony complained to Baba that one of his relations was out of employment for a long time in spite of the best efforts Shri signed to him that now he will get a service, and within a few days Waman heard from the same relation that he had succeeded to an exceptionally prospective job.

But for all that Baba was marked to be as fresh and active as ever. He freely indulged in his daily duties of inspection supervision writing printing & 'talking' (with signs) with the hundreds of visitors that kept pouring in through out the day.
